

Attention: CRAFTON Residents : IMPORTANT SCHEDULING INFORMATION

Please note Crafton now allows for **“Single Stream Recycling”**

All recyclable material can be commingled in one recycle bin.

Use the list on the reverse side to guide you in your household recycling efforts.

**Regular Curbside Collection: Garbage and refuse should be placed
at the curb after 4 p.m. on Monday and before 6 a.m. on Tuesday.**

Leaf Waste - The Public Works Department collects and composts leaf waste each year between October 1 through December 1 weather permitting. **Hedge cuttings, limbs and branches** - PA Act 101 prohibits these materials from inclusion in the waste stream, Public Works will collect anytime, please contact Borough Offices for special collection.

Waste Management has been instructed not to pick it up leaves during scheduled collection or hedge cuttings, limbs or branches. Please do not set **Leaf Waste** out for regular garbage collection between October 1st, through December 1st.

**As a Valued Customer of Waste Management you now Enjoy Single-Stream Recycling.
All of your recyclables can be placed together in the same bin! No sorting required!
The following can be placed in your curbside bin and mixed all-together:**

- ♻ Aluminum food and beverage containers with food debris removed. Labels do not need to be removed.
- ♻ Glass food and beverage containers with lids and food debris removed: Clear, Brown Green. Labels do not have to be removed.
- ♻ Natural and pigmented plastic narrow-neck containers with symbols 1,2,3,4,5,6,7 (milk bottles, water bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, bleach bottles, etc). Lids and food debris removed. Labels do not have to be removed.
- ♻ Ferrrous (Iron, steel, tin) cans with food debris removed.
- ♻ Newsprint – black and white or pigmented. Not bound or placed in bags.
- ♻ Construction paper, Kraft paper, cereal Boxes, shoe boxes, or similar.
- ♻ Printer paper, computer paper, copy paper.
- ♻ Junk Mail.
- ♻ Magazines, catalogs.
- ♻ Corrugated cardboard must be flattened and cut, and can be no larger than 14 x 14 inches.

List of Materials **Not Accepted** as Recyclables:

- ✗ Wax coated paper or cardboard.
- ✗ Any material with food debris (pizza boxes).
- ✗ Batteries of any kind.
- ✗ Polystyrene foam, foam cups or dinnerware, packing foam or peanuts, etc., of any kind.
- ✗ Light bulbs.
- ✗ Mirrors, window or auto glass, porcelain, ceramics, glass cookware/bake ware, microwave oven trays, drinking glasses, perfume/cologne bottles.
- ✗ Wood or Yard Waste,
Grass clippings can be bagged and set out with Trash collection.
- ✗ Unnumbered plastics.
- ✗ Coat hangers, Wire.
- ✗ Household items such as toasters, cookware, bake ware, electronics, appliances, etc.
- ✗ Hazardous or toxic substances.
- ✗ Items containing or having debris and residue containing hazardous or toxic substances such as paint cans with wet paint, motor oil containers, gasoline cans, glue, petroleum products, etc.
- ✗ Aerosol cans.

Service Notice: If a Holiday falls on or before your service day, service will be one day later. If the Holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, There will be no change in service.

Home Collection Program for Household Generated Special Materials

As part of the residential solid waste and recycling contract with Waste Management, you have a convenient opportunity to dispose of your household generated special materials- safely, easily and responsibly. The At Your Door Special CollectionSM program, a residential service offered by Waste Management, continues to provide year-round collections for you.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. To Participate, you must set up a collection appointment.

There are three ways to schedule a collection:

The Call Center Representatives will guide you through the steps toward a safe and successful collection. You will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of materials available for the pick up. You will be provided a convenient collection date and information about where to place the kit for collection. A kit will be sent to your home in plenty of time for you to gather and pack your materials.

2. Preparing for collection

The collection kit includes an instruction sheet and other items to help pack and secure your household generated special materials. Please read the instruction sheet included in the kit.

3. Material is collected

On the scheduled date, the service technician will collect materials directly from your home. They will sort and pack the materials for proper transportation, recycling and disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail back to help track the program.

4. You have more material than will fit into the Kit?

Remember, this service is available year-round. Just schedule another collection! Small quantities may be combined with your neighbors. Managing Household Hazardous Waste: The best method of managing Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is to prevent its generation in the first place. This involves selecting the least toxic item "to do the job" and buying only the minimum amounts necessary. Buying in large quantities is not a bargain if half of it has to be discarded. In the future, please consider buying environmentally friendly products.

Did You Know?

Latex paint is not a hazardous waste. It can often be donated to community groups and other organizations for re-use. Please consider this option before disposal.

Used motor oil is not hazardous, but may pollute our groundwater, waterways and soil if not properly managed. Many automotive station, auto parts and supply stores will accept used motor oil for recycling.

Automotive batteries may be exchanged at the place of purchase. Many battery retailers offer recycling even if you are not purchasing a new battery. In some cases, there may be a charge. Some scrap yards will also purchase lead acid batteries.
