As you may be aware, Allegheny County was declared a state of emergency from the June 20th storm event. As part of that declaration, residents with flood damage can call their local municipal emergency management coordinators to file a report. Below is a list of those numbers for each municipality in my district:

The municipal emergency management coordinator will enter your information into Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency's (PEMA) Damage Reporting System and this information will be shared with Allegheny County.

Pennsylvania and the Federal Emergency Management agencies will review all claims and will make a determination on whom is eligible for financial relief.
