Sealed Proposals will be received by Crafton Borough at the Borough Building, 100 Stotz Avenue, Crafton, PA 15205 until 10:00 a.m. prevailing time on Monday, August 28, 2017 for:

CRAFTON PARK IMPROVEMENTS

This project involves the installation of storm sewer system, a rain garden and the milling and overlay of an existing bituminous parking area at Crafton Park in Crafton, PA, including but not limited to, line stripping, storm sewer piping, inlets and manholes, and site signage.

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words "**CRAFTON PARK IMPROVEMENTS**".

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open to public inspection at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc., 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per set. No refund will be made for the return of any documents. An additional ten dollars (\$10.00) will be required for each set of plans if they are to be mailed.

Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement.

Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Rates must be paid on this contract.

Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Crafton Borough in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within 15 days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

All proposals must be in the hands of Ann Scott, Borough Manager, Crafton Borough, 100 Stotz Avenue, Crafton, PA 15205 on or before August 28, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. prevailing time and the same will be opened and read publicly immediately thereafter. The Proposals must be made to Crafton Borough, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting his Proposal guarantee.

The Bidder is advised that the Borough will award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder based on the total bid submitted. However, the bidder is advised that the Borough expressly reserves the right to reject all bids for any reason, and specifically reserves the right to award to the lowest responsible bidder a contract for all or any portions of the work listed in the proposal, and in awarding a contract for less than the total work listed, or less than all portions of the work listed, the contract price will be determined from the total quantities for each item listed and the unit price bid for each item listed.
