Sealed Proposals will be received by Crafton Borough at the Municipal Building, 100 Stotz Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15205 until 10:00 a.m. prevailing time on Wednesday, April 12, 2017 for:

2017 CRAFTON BOROUGH ROAD PROGRAM

Base Bid

This project involves Pavement Maintenance of various roadways throughout Crafton Borough, including the following approximate quantities: 18,310 SY of Bituminous Milling (3.5"+/-), 7,440 SY of Bituminous Milling (1.5" +/-), 880 SY of Soft Spot Repair, 170 LF 24" Keyway milling, 20 Ton of ¾" 9.5 mm Scratch Course, 2,260 TON of 2" 19 mm Superpave Binder, 24,640 SY of 1.5" 9.5 mm Fine Grade Superpave Wearing, 110 LF of Bituminous Wedge Curb, 280 LF of Concrete Curb, 1,380 SF Concrete Sidewalk, 920 SF of ADA Handicap Ramp replacements, 20 LF of 15" HDPE Storm Sewer, Replace 5 Pgh. Style Inlets with "M" Style Inlets, Line Striping, Traffic Control, Restoration and Resident Notification.

Add Alternate No. 1

This project involves removing and replacing approximately 3,680 SF Concrete Sidewalk, Traffic Control, Restoration and Resident Notification.

Add Alternate No. 2

This project involves Pavement Maintenance of various roadways throughout Crafton Borough, including the following approximate quantities: 3,020 SY of Bituminous Milling (3.5"+/-), 150 SY of Soft Spot Repair, 330 TON of 2" 19 mm Superpave Binder, 3,020 SY of 1.5" 9.5 mm Fine Grade Superpave Wearing, Traffic Control, Restoration and Resident Notification.

Add Alternate No. 3

This project involves Pavement Maintenance of various roadways throughout Crafton Borough, including the following approximate quantities: 2,090 SY of Bituminous Milling (3.5"+/-), 100 SY of Soft Spot Repair, 230 TON of 2" 19 mm Superpave Binder, 2,090 SY of 1.5" 9.5 mm Fine Grade Superpave Wearing, Replace Pgh. Style Inlets with "M" Style Inlets, Traffic Control, Restoration and Resident Notification.

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words "2017 CRAFTON BOROUGH ROAD PROGRAM".

All bidders shall be PennDOT pre-qualified and submit their PennDOT Pre-Qualification Certificates as well as the Anti-Collusion Affidavit with the Proposal in order for the Proposal to be considered responsive.

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open to public inspection at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc., 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205-9401 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of \$50.00 per set. No refund will be made for the return of any documents. An additional \$10.00 will be required for each set of plans if they are to be mailed.

Pennsylvania Prevailing Wages must be paid on this contract.

Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Crafton Borough in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within 15 days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

All Proposals must be in the hands of Crafton Borough, 100 Stotz Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15205, by 10:00 A.M. prevailing time, April 12, 2017 and the same will be opened and read publicly immediately thereafter. The Proposals must be made to Crafton Borough, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of ninety (90) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the ninety (90) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee.

Performance, Maintenance, and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement upon acceptance of the Proposal from the successful Bidder.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein.
